



Quick Guidelines for Potential Eligibility

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program provides a monthly allotment for food via the Michigan Bridge Card that beneficiaries can use like a debit card to buy most food or food products at grocery stores and participating farmers markets.

Medicare Savings Program (MSP)

The Medicare Savings Program helps pay Medicare premiums, co-pays and deductibles. If eligible, your client will no longer have the Medicare Part B premium of \$104.90 or more taken out of their Social Security check.

Low-Income Subsidy (LIS)

The Low-Income Subsidy helps with prescription drug costs. Eligible seniors will receive help with monthly premiums, deductibles, and co-pays.
